


Guide to Downloading the Windows XML File for eduroam and Configuration

1. Visit the Website


Open your web browser and navigate to:
<https://servicecenter-khs.de/sc-it/formulare>.




2. Download the XML File

Look for the link to the Windows XML file for HfM, HfS, and khb.

- Right-click on the link and select “Save link as...”.




- Save the file in an easily accessible location, such as your Downloads folder.



3. Open Terminal

- Hold down the Shift key and right-click on an empty space in the folder where you saved the XML file.
- Select “Open terminal here” or “Open PowerShell here” from the context menu.



4. Delete Old eduroam Settings

To ensure the new configuration can be successfully applied, delete the old settings. Enter the following command and press Enter:

```
netsh wlan delete profile name="eduroam"
```

5. Add New Settings

To add the new configuration, enter the following command and press Enter:

```
netsh wlan add profile filename=.\eduroam.xml
```

6. Connect to eduroam

- Click on the Wi-Fi icon in the taskbar.
- Select “eduroam” from the list of available networks.
- Click on “Connect.”
- Enter your username and password. Please refer to the password letter for your username and password.
- Click “OK” or “Connect” to establish the connection.
